

# Prescription Drug Benefits: Strong Coverage and Real Savings

Timely access to affordable medications means a lot to you.

#### So it means a lot to us.

All of our Medicare plans with prescription drug coverage offer a \$0 pharmacy deductible, allowing you to immediately take advantage of low or \$0 copays for Tier 1 and Tier 2 drugs in your plan's formulary—including many generics.

This means your prescription drug savings start as soon as your plan does!



#### Formulary:

Your plan's list of covered drugs, split into 5 tiers; based on your plan, you pay the same copay or coinsurance for all drugs in each tier. For example, you might pay a \$0 copay for a Tier 1 (generic) drug, or 33% coinsurance for a Tier 5 (specialty) drug.

#### Part D:

Medicare drug coverage, which is built into all of our Medicare Advantage plans except for Core. If you don't enroll in a Part D plan as soon as you're eligible, you may have to pay a penalty.

#### **Rx Changes for 2025**

**Initial Coverage:** During this phase, your prescription copays and coinsurance, along with costs we pay for supplemental Rx coverage, count toward your out-of-pocket limit, which has decreased to \$2,000 starting in 2025.


**Catastrophic Coverage:** If your out-of-pocket costs reach \$2,000, you enter this final phase of Medicare Part D. Here, you will pay \$0 for covered Part D drugs.

**Medicare Prescription Payment Plan:** You'll have the option of paying out-of-pocket prescription drug costs in the form of capped monthly payments instead of all at once at the pharmacy, which is also new for 2025.



#### **BlueCHiP for Medicare Core (HMO)**

**Don't need Part D coverage (prescription drugs) because you have creditable coverage elsewhere?** For example, if you're a veteran of the U.S. military with drug coverage through the VA, our Core plan could be an option. Keep in mind that, unlike Value, Enhanced, and Extra, Core also doesn't include a point of service (POS) benefit, meaning you'd have no out-of-network coverage.
